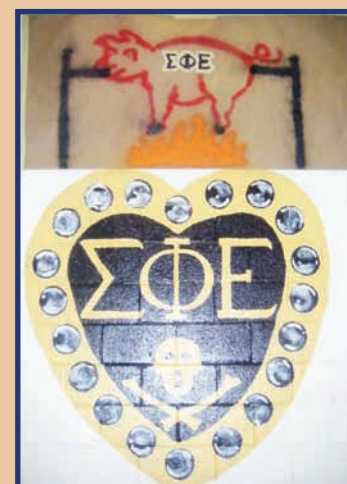
Schedule of Events:
